For your information we are training the children to "cough into your elbow". That might contradict what you have been teaching but at a seminar we learned it is more appropriate and healthy. When a child sneezes or coughs, the elbow catches whatever escapes. Thank you for your cooperation.

We will be conducting monthly fire drills. The Town Fire Marshall has strongly urged us to ring the fire alarm during the drills so that the children become accustomed to the loud sound. The Pre-K and MWF students will visit the Jonesville Fire Station on Wednesday, October 8th.



Our Harvest Celebration will be Thursday and Friday, at the end of October on the 30 & 31. We do not celebrate Halloween with costumes. At our Harvest Celebration the children will make a special snack, which the snack person can initiate. We do not go outside on party days. The girls and boys may wear their "party clothes".

Our library should be ready for lending by the middle of this month. We have books/tapes for parents as well as for the children.
