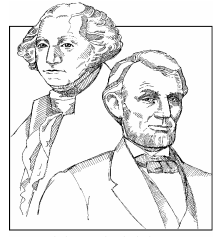


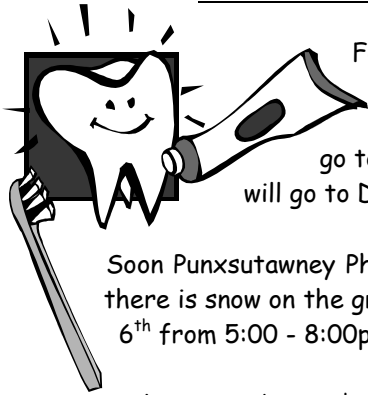

The snack person for that week should be the first to sign up on the Valentine Refreshment poster. **IMPORTANT! Please do not personalize the valentines.** It would be great if you and your child work together signing his/her name as the sender. We are going to pretend to be a mail carrier and deliver each valentine to a mail "folder/bag".
