Happy New Year! It is so good to see snow as we move into the year 2004. We hope everyone made their new year's resolutions, which will probably last for less than a month.

We are now taking registration for September 2004. Be sure you have validated your child's placement with a \$25.00 registration fee.

Clifton Park Center Baptist Preschool will not always close when Shenendehowa School has a one to two hour delay. You will receive a phone call saying we are open. Of course, you must use your own judgment as to whether you want to venture out on a particular snowy morning. When Shenendehowa School is closed due to weather, most likely we will be closed.



Our daily schedule includes outside time. Please send the proper clothing each day in a stirrup-handled bag with your child's name printed boldly on the bag. The children have

learned to take responsibility for their own belongings, a skill that will benefit everyone. You will notice a monthly calendar on the bulletin board. There are spaces provided for you to sign in, to come back at 11 o'clock to help us get dressed for outside time.

Beginning in January we will be focusing on the sense of "TOUCH". That means most of the activities revolve around the sense of touch. Each month we will learn about one of our five senses.

January 22, 23 have been set aside for our annual "Jr. Olympics". The children can wear warm up suits and definitely SNEAKERS. The report you receive on that day will give you some indication of your child's developmental ability at this time. Each child will receive a "medal" for their participation. We will observe climbing, stepping, crawling, going over, going under and walking on the balance beam. Please remember whatever we do is a FUN and sometimes different way to experience our God given skills and talents.

A visit to Hannaford Market is to be announced. We WILL have school on Monday, Martin Luther King Day. The children do not understand the significance of Martin Luther King at this level of development.

February is National Dental Health Month. The three day class will visit Dr. Trager on Vischer Ferry Road. A dental hygienist from Dr. Davidson's office will visit the two day class.
